

TAMMIN PRIMARY SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY



Wearing the Tammin Primary School uniform plays an important part in establishing a positive community identity and contributes to the creation of an appropriate work ethic. Acceptance of enrolment at Tammin Primary School assumes an agreement between the parent and the student that the student will dress in accordance with the school's uniform policy. Every student is expected to comply with the uniform policy in the same way that they are expected to comply with the rules relating to classroom behaviour, punctuality and so on.

GUIDELINES

Students are to wear the designated uniform during school hours, to and from school and while attending school excursions. Parents are asked to cooperate by ensuring that students wear their uniform to school every day. It is the expectation that students will be dressed in uniforms that are clean, neat and tidy at all times.

CONSEQUENCES OF BREACHING THE TAMMIN PRIMARY SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

When a student is out of uniform, they will be asked to report to the Administration Office to change into an appropriate uniform item and remove the non-uniform item. Parents will be contacted to deliver the appropriate uniform item. The non-uniform item will be placed into a bag, clearly labelled with the date. The bagged item will be stored in the Administration Office and can be collected/ swapped at the end of the day. Parents of repeat non complying students will be contacted and support will be offered to resolve concerns.

Principal will work with individual families to provide appropriate processes for exemption or modification related to student health, cultural considerations, or any other matter, which in the Principal's opinion, is sufficient to exempt a student from the dress code requirements.

Families who may experience financial difficulties regarding the purchase of a uniform should contact the Principal to seek a solution.
