Anzac Assembly

On Thursday the 2nd of May, Tammin Primary School held its annual Anzac Assembly. We were excited to share our research about the local service men who fought in World War 1.

Frank Packham was born in Kalong Vale, Victoria 1888. He was sent to Bullecourt in France as a soldier. He was very courageous and took out a machine gun area. He was unfortunately shot in the leg and shipped back to England to recover. He later returned to Tammin to start a family with the nurse he met and married.

Harry York was born in Buenos Aires, Argentina 1891. He was enlisted as a telephone liner and was then sent to the front line. He too unfortunately got shot in the left hand. He later recovered and returned to Tammin to farm with his brother Herbert.

Stanley Franklin was born in December, 1890. He was a foot soldier with his horse and rifle. He was sent to Egypt where he was wounded in his elbow. He was treated and sent back to the war. He developed an illness and was sent back to Australia.

Thank you to Mr Rees, Mrs Button, Mrs York and Mrs Packham for sharing some history about Tammin. We would also like to thank everyone who attended our Anzac Assembly.
