YEAR 3/4 Experiments and story telling









In Science we have been looking at different types of soils, rocks and landscapes around us. We have conducted several experiments looking at the different features of soil and rocks and how they can change over time. Our latest experiment was to explore the effects of water erosion and see if different variables can slow down the erosion. They are at the back of the classroom if you would like to have a look at them.





































Tiny Tots First Aid

Who this course is recommended for:
