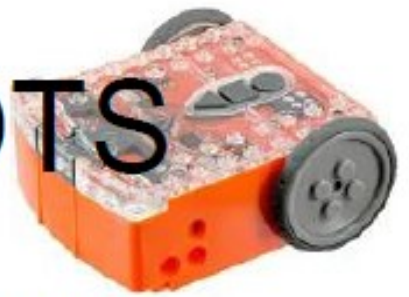

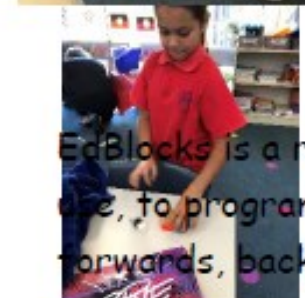
EDISON ROBOTS

YEAR 3 AND 4



This term the class has been having a lot of fun learning about Edison-the programmable robot. It can be programmed in different ways. They have learnt how to do this by using barcodes and a program on the iPad. Many things about robotics and programming have been discovered. The class has programmed Edison to do the following.

- Clap control driving
- Avoid Obstacles
- Follow a torch
- Line Tracking
- Bounce in Borders
- Sumo wrestle



EdBlocks is a robot programming language that the children have learnt how to use, to program Edison. They've been able to program the robots to drive forwards, backwards and turn corners.



Some of the challenges are listed below.

Challenge 1 was to write a program using EdBlocks to drive Edison from a start line and stop driving it after crossing the finish line.



Challenge 2 was to program Edison to turn left or right for a set amount of time.



Challenge 3 was to design a program that will get Edison through a set maze.
