



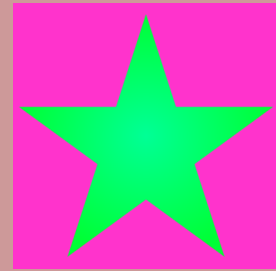

FRIDAY 22ND NOVEMBER 2019

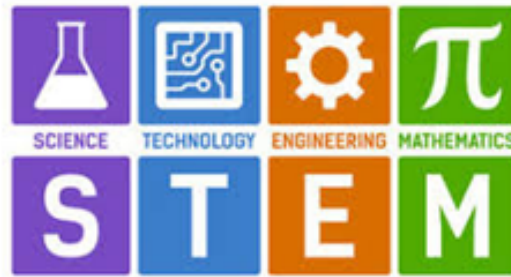
The year 3 and 4 class have been very busy preparing for the STEM sharing afternoon on Friday 22nd November.

YEAR 3 /4 CLASS STEM PROJECTS

**This term we are looking at the steps
involved in a S.T.E.M. Project.**

1. **ASK**- What is the problem? What do I already know?
2. **IMAGINE** – Brainstorm and research ideas to solve the problem.
3. **PLAN** – Draw a diagram, make a list of steps and materials needed.
4. **CREATE** – Follow the Plan and test out it out.
5. **IMPROVE** – Did it work? Modify Plan-what else would work better?
