On the day, the students completed three robot challenges, presented their innovation project and talked about values. Twenty one teams competed, entering both primary and high school students with experienced and novice competitors. In the robot challenges all three teams ranked in the top 16. They should be so proud of their efforts. Our all girl team 'The Biscotti Pogs' took out the award for best model in the innovation challenge. Once the girls have finished sharing it with their family's, the award will be displayed proudly in the school office. What a great experience for our students.
