



In Digital Technology this term we have been learning how to code using the Sphero. Sphero is a robot ball with several features that can be controlled through mobile apps, including computer programs that the students build.



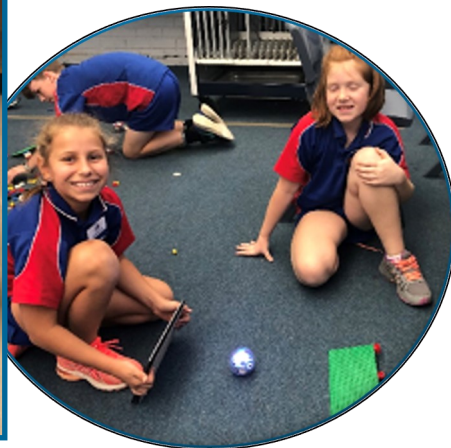
The main features are:

Rolling - The Sphero can roll at a given speed and heading for a given amount of time.

Colours - The Sphero can light up in any color.

Draw and Drive- This allows the students to draw a shape with multiple colours and have Sphero roll in that shape and color.

It is a remarkably cool, programmable robots and STEM-based educational tool that transforms the way the students learn, create, and invent through coding, science, music, and the arts. The Sphero is designed for exploration, experimentation, and creativeness and the students have had the most exciting times with them.

BEING A SAFE PASSENGER
