
In Digital Technology this term we have been learning how to code using the Sphero. Sphero is a robot ball with several features that can be controlled through mobile apps,

Sit in the back seat it is safer. It is the law.


Buckle up! All passengers in a car MUST wear a seatbelt or child restraint. It is the law.
