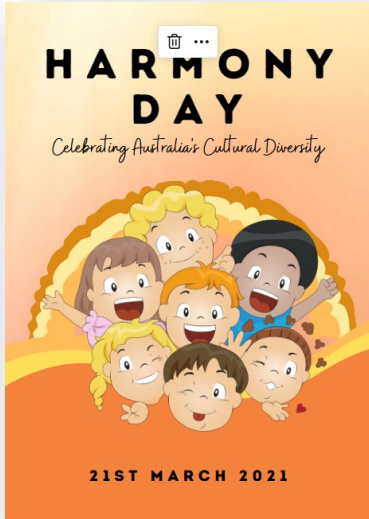

# HARMONY DAY

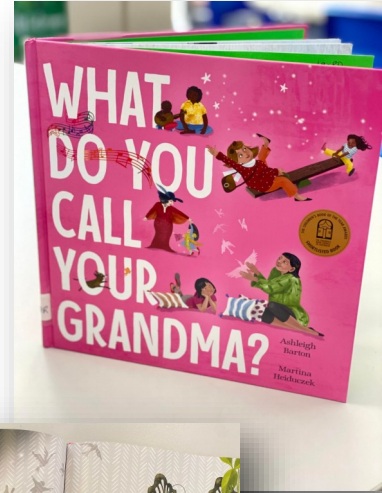


On Harmony Day the Students were encouraged to wear the colour Orange to school. Orange signifies social communication and meaningful conversations.

# Senior Class

## Science – Solids, Liquids & Gasses

In Science we have looked into what it is like to be an astronaut living at the International Space Station. We explored some new language linked to solids, liquids and gasses by learning how astronauts eat ice cream. We tasted some freeze-dried astronaut ice-cream and changed the state of some from a solid to a liquid. We put the mixture into the freezer hoping it will turn back into a solid overnight for a tasty treat!



## STEM – Sewing

We have been putting our sewing skills to the test! All students chose an animal pattern to put together. They got busy tracing and cutting out all parts of their pattern and began sewing. We found threading needles to be a challenge, but no one has pricked their fingers yet! Their animal creations are coming along nicely. ## Visual Arts – Watercolour Techniques

In art we have been exploring different watercolour techniques. We learned a 'puddling' technique used to create depth and interest around water. We drew an underwater jelly fish scene using oil pastels and then painted on blue watercolour leaving puddles on the page to dry to create this effect.
